
HOW TO PREVENT TOOSQUITOES!



Adult mosquitoes lay eggs in stagnant or slow moving water, and on moist soil or leaf litter in areas likely to collect water. By eliminating these water sources, you can keep new generations of mosquitoes from taking up residence in your yard.

Eliminate Standing Water Sources

- 1. Uncovered Boats
- 2. Open Trash Bins
- 3. Fountains and Bird Baths
- 4. Clogged Rain Gutters
- 5. Low Areas
- 6. Potted Plant Saucers
- 7. Water Bowls for Pets
- 8. Buckets and Barrels
- 9. Leaky Hoses
- 10. Wagons and Other Toys
- 11. Neglected Pools
- 12. Ponds
- 13. Tires
- 14. Rot Holes in Trees

Protect Yourself From Mosquito Bites

- USE INSECT REPELLENT Look for active ingredients like DEET, Picaridin, or IR3535.
- WEAR PROTECTIVE CLOTHES Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants. Treat clothes with permethrin for greater protection.
- · MOSQUITO-PROOF YOUR HOME Keep screens on windows and doors closed. Use air conditioning when available.
